What has been happening

In July 2024, we paused our design process to find a new architect for the project. Since our last newsletter, we've been working in the background by:

- Running a procurement process and appointing Archio as our architects
- Sharing past feedback from residents and neighbours with Archio
- Carrying out surveys, including utilities assessments, to ensure existing provisions are accounted for from the outset
- Appoint a daylight/sunlight consultant to support and assess the impact of any proposed development
- Continuing to work closely with Adult Social Care and addressing your questions about the future of the project.



We are proposing a building made up of six supported living homes, designed for residents with autism and/or learning disabilities, and let at social rent. The proposed building would also include shared areas to help residents live as independently as possible.



Archio are a north London-based architecture practice who create buildings, places and strategies for local authorities, housing associations and community groups.
